

Ranby Football Club - Club Safety Rules

The club safety rules have been put in place to ensure the safety of all participants and spectators during any event involving Ranby Football Club. This is including open sessions, training and any matches taking place involving Ranby Football Club at the following address: Ranby Fun Field, Old Blyth Road, Ranby, Nottinghamshire. DN22 8HZ.

These are additional rules that will be enforced alongside The FA Rules and Regulations that ensure fair play in the grassroots game, both on and off the pitch.

Club safety rules for all participants.

- No chewing gum
- Jewellery to be removed before any session starts
- Shin guards must be worn
- Correct footwear for the conditions must be worn
- If arriving by bicycle, helmets must be worn, and lights must be fitted where applicable.
- Any injuries or illness must be reported immediately to the coach in charge of the event
- Please ensure football boots are removed prior to, and after leaving the playing area.

Club safety rules for all parents/guardians/spectators.

- No smoking on the club grounds
- No encroaching onto the training/event area whilst the event is taking place (unless in an emergency)
- No foul language or inappropriate behaviour towards ANY of the participants or Ranby Football Club staff
- Ensure any siblings, if in attendance, are always supervised
- Please dispose of all litter in the bins provided
- Report any issues regarding the participant to the coach in charge of the session
- Please park responsibly when attending the event, DO NOT block residents driveways or park on grass verges
- Ensure all participants football boots are removed prior to and after leaving the playing area. No boots allowed on the school driveway
